### <u>Item k.1</u> <u>Coordinator's Report – Teresa Ezquerra</u>

- Sharing of Excellence Series The month of September featured two Celebrating Inclusion topics from Student Services: How to Write an Effective IEP and Assistive Technology Refresher. Teresa Ezquerra, Coordinator, supported staff on how to create IEPs that meet the individual programming needs of our students. Kate Remiz, AT Coordinator, and the Assistive Technology Team provided a refresher session on the use of Assistive software, including Word Q, Smart Ideas, and Kurzweil.
- Secondary teachers of Alternative Curriculum courses attended an "Equals Math" session on Monday, October 5th. The purpose of this training opportunity was to support teachers in the delivery of curriculum for students with a variety of learning needs and abilities. These teachers will also attend "Structured Teaching" training on November 16th and 30th. Structured Teaching will assist teachers in preparing students with ASD and/or other related disorders for the workplace by maximizing task independence.

## <u>Item k.1</u> <u>Coordinator's Report – continued</u>

- DCDSB and SEAC are hosting our third annual "Pathways to the Future....Looking Beyond Secondary School" event on Tuesday November 3. Students, parents, educators and administrators are welcome to attend the session from 1-3 or 6-8 at the Catholic Education Centre Conference Centre. Program Support teachers will be attending one of the sessions. SEAC members are welcome to join us to share information at our SEAC booth. The various agencies will cover topics such as community services, employment opportunities, recreational opportunities, community resources and college/university preparation.
- **Mental Health Update:** Our safeTALK training on September 23 was well-attended by a diverse group including teachers, EAs, schools secretaries and central board staff.

SEAC was successful in securing a \$10 000 Pro Grant. The grant will be used to organize three conferences for parents – the Pathways to the Future event in November, a Mental Health focused parent session in February and a parent event in April- similar to last year's Autism Awareness Conference.

The first Program Support Teacher meeting of the year took place in September and principals attended. It was a productive meeting and the principals and program support teachers appreciated the opportunity to come together to learn about Student Services' strategic priorities for the coming year.
